Best's 2017 Great Western Chardonnay

Chardonnay was one of the varietals planted first in the Concongella Vineyard in the 1970's even though cuttings were extremely hard to come by at the time. This wine comes from an old single vineyard located on a cool sheltered site within the Great Western GI.

Our winemaker Justin Purser has considerable experience and a passion for making chardonnay. He assisted during four vintages with outstanding chardonnay producer Domaine de Montille in Meursault, Burgundy before taking his position at Best's.

Tasting Notes

Colour	Pale straw with gold hints.
Bouquet	Complex aromas of honeycomb, stuck match, grapefruit and white peaches.
Palate	Great purity and finesse with the white peach and savoury characters being pulled by the fresh minerality that carries it to a long finish. Try it with Sushi.
Cellaring	This wine is drinking well now but will mature gracefully over the next 10-15 years.
