2019 CONCONGELLA BLANC

Made from Henry Best's first plantings at our Concongella vineyard, the historic Nursery Block is a veritable vineyard museum with 39 separate varieties, eight remaining unknown and unnamed to this day. This is a wine that speaks more about history, soil and place than variety, a unique expression of our Australian wine heritage.

Tasting Notes

Colour	Pale straw with brassy highlights.
Bouquet	The very old vines offer deep and complex aromatics. Portuguese tart, Shortbread, Nashi Pear, Pawpaw and Lemon Verbena to name a few.
Palate	Mouth filling and viscous but the fresh and vibrant fruit keeps it light on its feet. The latticework of flavour continues to unfurl and expand for several delectable moments. A great aperitif or as a food wine with Steamed Pork Dumplings.
Vintage	A warm, dry growing season meant that the vines ripened quickly and crops were lower than average. Sufficient water supply ensured the grapevines remained in good health and some February rain gave the vines a well-deserved drink and freshened them up before the grapes were harvested.
