



## TASTING NOTE

# 2019 PINOT MEUNIER / PINOT NOIR

This unique wine comes from our 'Young Vine' plantings of Pinot Meunier which were established in 1970- a century after our original "old vine" plantings.

The addition of a small amount of Best's 'Old Clone' Pinot Noir to this wine has added an extra dimension and richness. Although eminently drinkable now, previous examples of this blend prove that it will age gracefully for many decades if cellared correctly.

<b>Growing Region</b>	Great Western, Victoria
<b>Grape Varieties</b>	Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir
<b>Alcohol</b>	13.5 %
<b>Winemaker</b>	Justin Purser

### Tasting Notes

<b>Colour</b>	Bright red with a pale crimson hue
<b>Bouquet</b>	Spicy sour cherry, cranberry and other red fruits with hints of orange peel and flowers.
<b>Palate</b>	Medium bodied with waves of fresh red fruit and soft and savoury tannins that carry the long finish.  Good to drink in the short term but it should age well for 20 years or more
<b>Vintage</b>	A warm, dry growing season meant the vines ripened quickly and crops were lower than average. Sufficient water supply ensured the grapevines remained in good health and some February rain gave the vines a well-deserved drink and freshened them up before the grapes were harvested.
