



TASTING NOTE

2020 GREAT WESTERN CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay was one of the varietals planted first in the Concongella Vineyard in the 1970's even though cuttings were extremely hard to come by at the time. This wine comes from an old single vineyard located on a cool sheltered site within the Great Western GI.

Our winemaker Justin Purser has considerable experience and a passion for making chardonnay. He assisted during four vintages with outstanding chardonnay producer Domaine de Montille in Meursault, Burgundy before taking his position at Best's.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: Bright Pale straw with a green hue.

Bouquet: Attractive aromas of struck match, almonds and fresh straw. It evolves to show honeydew and melon notes.

Palate: This wine has a viscous salivating flavour with pithy white nectarine and a vibrant acidity. Try it with grilled marinated chicken with grilled veg on the side.

Cellaring: 5 – 10 years

Vintage: A hot and dry growing season meant the vines ripened quickly and crops were lower than average. Sufficient water supply ensured the grapevines remained in good health and a cool February ensured all the natural acidity was retained at harvest. The grapes had bundles of concentrated flavour and lots of vibrant acidity.
