2020 CONCONGELLA BLANC

Made from Henry Best's first plantings at our Concongella vineyard, the historic Nursery Block is a veritable vineyard museum with 39 separate varieties, eight remaining unknown and unnamed to this day. This is a wine that speaks more about history, soil and place than variety, a unique expression of our Australian wine heritage.

Tasting Notes

Colour	Pale straw with flashes of green and gold.
Bouquet	Layered and inviting aromas of honeydew melon, parsley and preserved lemons.
Palate	A fine lacy texture surrounds the plush melon flavours and rounded acidity to compliment the dry savoury finish. Delicious served with a platter of cheeses and crusty bread.
Vintage	A hot and dry growing season meant the vines ripened quickly and crops were lower than average. Sufficient water supply ensured the grapevines remained in good health and a cool February ensured all the natural acidity was retained at harvest. The grapes had bundles of concentrated flavour and lots of vibrant acidity.
