2020 GREAT WESTERN ROSE

By taking the free run juice from predominantly Pinot Noir grapes with smaller amounts of Pinot Meunier and Shiraz off our estate vineyards we have created a vibrant Rosé that can be drunk chilled with food or as an aperitif.

The go-to drink for a lazy summer's afternoon.

Region:	Great Western, Victoria
Grape Variety:	Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Shiraz
Alcohol:	12.0%

TASTING NOTES

Colour	Very pale salmon, with an onion skin hue.
Bouquet	Lifted and complete with white strawberry, mandarin and melon skin aromas followed by secondaries of bread dough and macadamia nuts.
Palate	Fresh, but creamy with salivating white peach and mandarin flavours and a dry persistent finish. Bring it to a picnic, with lots of fresh salads, creamy cheeses and crusty bread.
Vintage	A hot and dry growing season meant the vines ripened quickly and crops were lower than average. Sufficient water supply ensured the grapevines remained in good health and a cool February ensured all the natural acidity was retained at harvest. The grapes had bundles of concentrated flavour and lots of vibrant acidity.
