

TASTING NOTE

2021 GREAT WESTERN CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay was one of the varietals planted in the Concongella Vineyard in the 1970's despite the fact that cuttings were extremely hard to come by at the time. The fruit for this wine comes from an old single vineyard located in a cool sheltered site within the Great Western GI.

Our Chardonnay is aged for 10 months in older French puncheons, with a lot of lees contact, both of which help to develop a rich and complex wine with plenty of texture. Our 2021 vintage is beautifully balanced and made in style more akin to the older styles from Best's.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: White-Gold with a slight green hue.

Bouquet: Attractive flinty aroma, with savory notes of malt and roasted hazelnuts with an underlying lime citrus.

Palate: Flavors of white-nectarine stone fruit, coupled with a long-creamy mid-palate and fresh lime rind acidity. Making this wine complex and enjoyable for all occasions. Best pared with roasted crispy skinned chicken.
